



Dear Parents,

We are coming to the end of our great saga of the year 2020: Confinement and Deconfinement!

Following the new protocol issued last night by the Ministry of National Education, we will make some changes to our routine in recent weeks:

## **Elementary:**

The watchword of this new protocol is: *"Distance between students should be sought as much as possible."*

There must be 1 meter between children. This therefore has a direct implication on our reception capacity. We are unable to welcome all the children back **at the same time**. On the other hand, we can make half-groups with a little more of children and thus welcome all the children by the end of next week, **in half-groups**.

Below is a table that shows, in your child's grade, how many more students can return, by period.

Please let us know the day you want to bring your child back so that we can quickly tell you if they can be received.

For children who are already back to school, the days remain the same. For those who will be at home, the Distance Learning will continue for one last week.

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### **Wednesday June 24:**

In order to allow elementary children to meet one last time before the end of the school year, we will welcome them **all** outside (where physical distancing is no longer required) to participate in games and share a last moment together. The schedule and places of entry and exit will be the same as on other days.

**WARNING ! There will be no canteen that day.**

### **English 60/40:**

Next week, children will be able to go with their regular English teacher, *as long as physical distancing in the classroom is possible.*

### **Canteen:**

As has been the case since back to school, we will continue to provide half-board children with cold meals in the form of packed lunches.

### **Recreations:**

We will continue with staggered moments of recreation, to allow children to have access to sanitary facilities for hand washing, in good hygienic conditions.

### **Parents:**

The presence of parents in the school is still not allowed: children will be dropped off and picked up at the gate.

### **Last day of class:**

For **group 1** children, last day of class will be **Wednesday June 24, at the end of the morning** but the children will receive work for the last two days.

For **group 2** children, **last day of school will be Friday, June 26, after classes.**

If I do not have the opportunity to see you again before the holidays, I wanted first of all to thank you for your support, your involvement and your courage during all this strange period and then to wish you a very relaxing holiday (and a "normal" back to school in September!).
